## FACILITIES

At Mzuzu International Academy, we have superb boarding. The rooms are large and have modern furniture for studying at night. The bathrooms are super clean and welcoming. We wanted the boarding house to feel natural and cozy, so we have a lot of the natural environment around. Boys and girls are housed in separate compounds, each with a common room area and washing rooms. We pick rooms based on what grade the students are in. It's like a second home away from home!



## MENU

We have delicious meals like chicken nkhwaskwasu and rice, fish and nsima, sausage and potatoes, a variety of salads and so much more! All our food is purchased from halaal certified suppliers.

# TYPICAL DAY AT MIA

A school day at MIA goes as follows:

- **06:30 am - 7:15 am** : Breakfast
- **07:30 am - 08:10 am** : Tutor group meeting
- **08:10 am - 12:40 pm** : Classes
- **12:40 am - 13:40 pm** : Lunch
- **13:40 pm - 15:20 pm** : Classes
- **15:20 pm - 16:30 pm** : Clubs
- **16:30 pm - 17:00 pm** : Break
- **17:00 pm - 18:00 pm** : Supper
- **18:00 pm - 20:00 pm** : Prep
- **21:00 pm** : Lights out.

Weekends at MIA Boarding School strike a balance between relaxation and academics. Saturdays feature sports and leisure activities, including board games and trips to the nearby lake, while evenings are reserved for movie nights to foster community. Sunday mornings prioritize study sessions, ensuring academic commitments are met. The weekend concludes with dinner, offering students a well-rounded experience that combines recreation and academic focus.

## HOW TO APPLY

### STEP 1

Families looking to enrol in boarding need to send an email to [admissions@mzuzuacademy.org](mailto:admissions@mzuzuacademy.org) stating their interest or fill out an inquiry form on our website at <https://miasms.mzuzuacademy.org/admission-inquiry/>. The email must include the name of the child and what year you are looking to enrol them.

### STEP 2

Fill out an application form which will be sent to you. Accompanying the application form should be a transfer letter, copy of a Birth Certificate or any document to verify DOB and a current school report from previous school.

### STEP 3

A communication from the school with a date and time of Entrance Assessment, you will be required to pay the assessment fee on the day of the Assessment. Note that MIA sets assessment dates in Lilongwe and Blantyre for families who want to join us at the beginning of the academic year. You can keep a lookout on our website and social media pages for the specific dates.

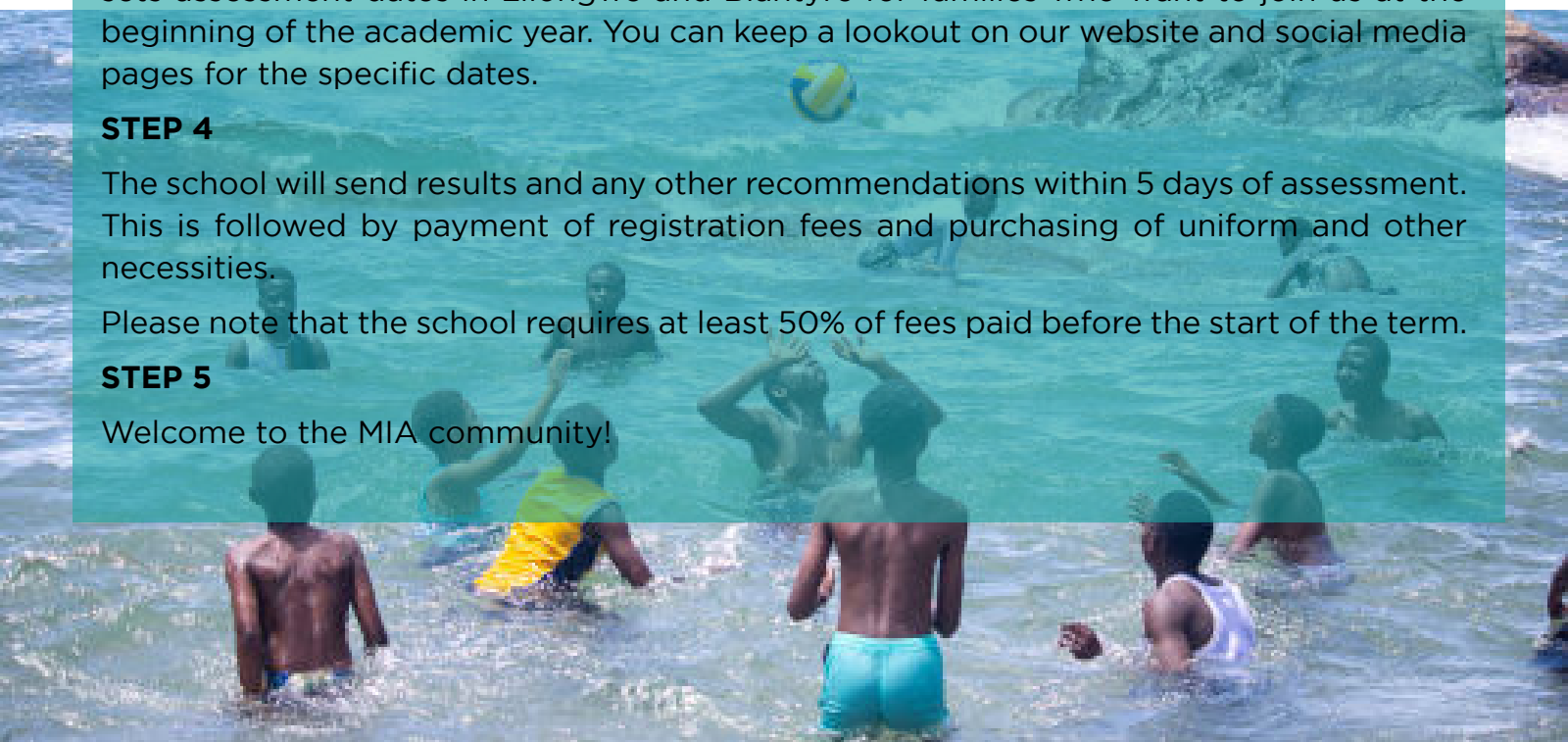
### STEP 4

The school will send results and any other recommendations within 5 days of assessment. This is followed by payment of registration fees and purchasing of uniform and other necessities.

Please note that the school requires at least 50% of fees paid before the start of the term.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## Are my children allowed to go to Church/Mosque?

- Yes. We allow our students to practice their faith. We organise transport on weekends to take the students to their respective churches/mosque.

## How does boarding handle students' health and well-being?

- As a school, child safety and well-being are our top priorities. We have dedicated boarding staff, including two nurses, to address students' health and well-being. We have on-campus health services and protocols for medical emergencies.

## How many times are parents allowed to visit in a term?

- Once, this is organised by the school and is slotted on the school calendar for your planning purposes. Additionally, we do not allow relatives/family to visit without permission from the school.

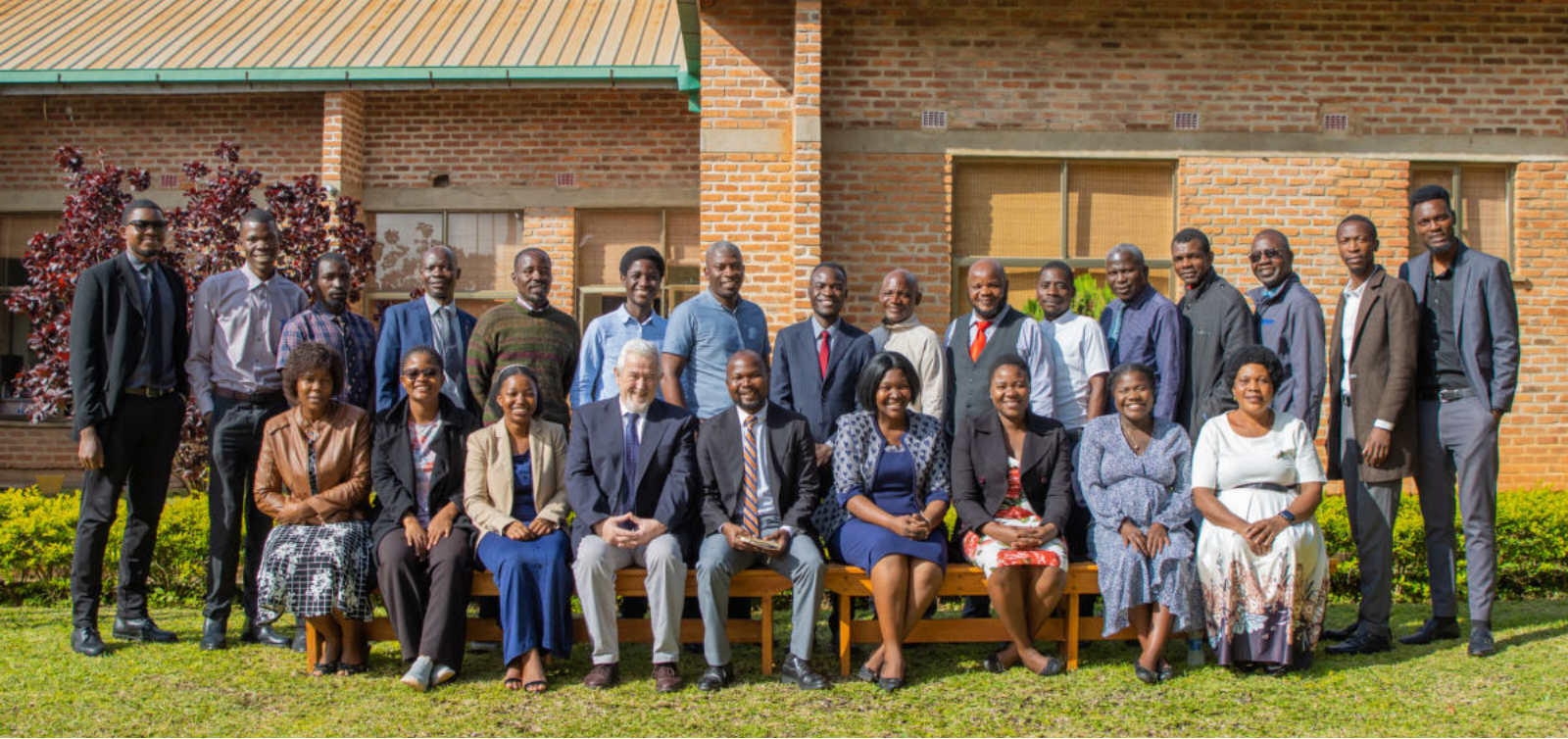
## Can students go home during weekends or holidays?
